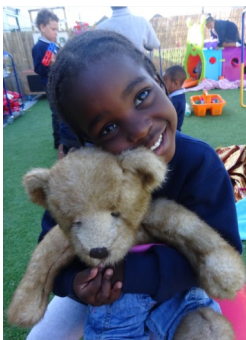
## Tea with the Queen
